The University

The International Hellenic University is the first Greek **public** University where all programmes are **taught exclusively in English**. The University has a **strong faculty** of **internationally distinguished academics**.

The Programme

The IHU “Master of Science in Energy Law, Business, Regulation and Policy” has as its objective the provision of postgraduate level studies, specialization and experience in Energy Law, Business, Energy Policy, and Geostrategy, as well as the general regulatory intervention in the area of the energy sector as a whole. It offers a highly flexible qualification suitable for a wide range of career opportunities in many sectors.

Target Audience

University and Technological Educational Institutes graduates in related subject areas, such as Law & Political Sciences, Economics, Business Studies & Engineering, with a strong motivation to pursue a career in energy related domains.

Programme Structure

During the first term, all students are required to follow 5 mandatory core courses. During the second term, all students follow a further 4 core courses and 2 elective courses. Finally, during the third term, work is dedicated exclusively to the Master’s dissertation.

Schedule:

The MSc in Energy Law, Business, Regulation and Policy (full-time mode) is a 14-month programme taught over three terms. Lectures take place on **weekends**. It is also available in part-time mode over 26 months for those who cannot commit to a full-time programme either due to work commitments or other reasons.

Admission Criteria/Entry Requirements

- A good university degree from a recognised university
- Proof of English competence (recently acquired IELTS /TOEFL/TOEIC or Proficiency).

Application

The University operates on a rolling admissions basis. This means that candidates apply for and are admitted to the MSc all year round until all the available places are filled. The programme begins in October 2015.
